

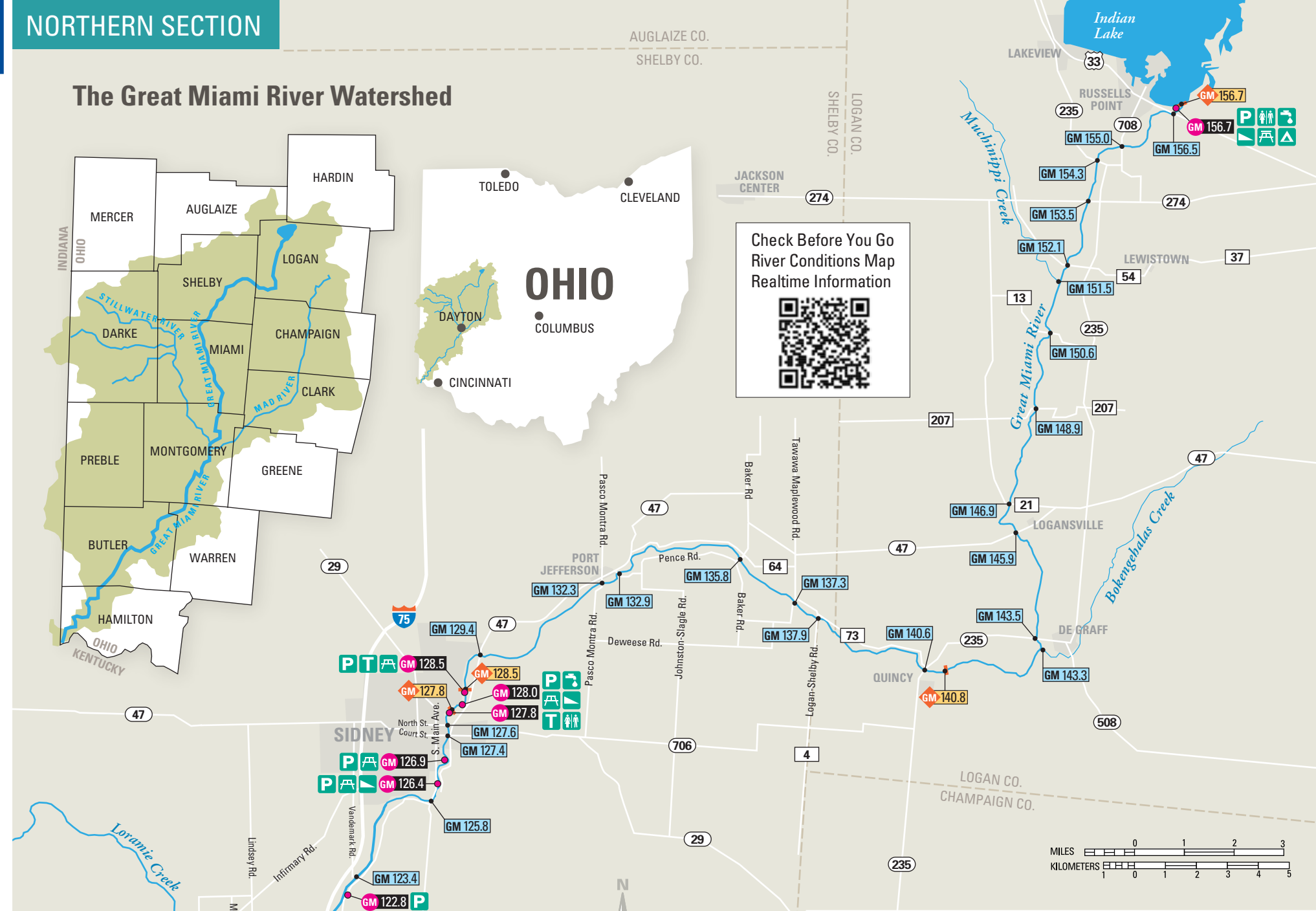
Great Miami River

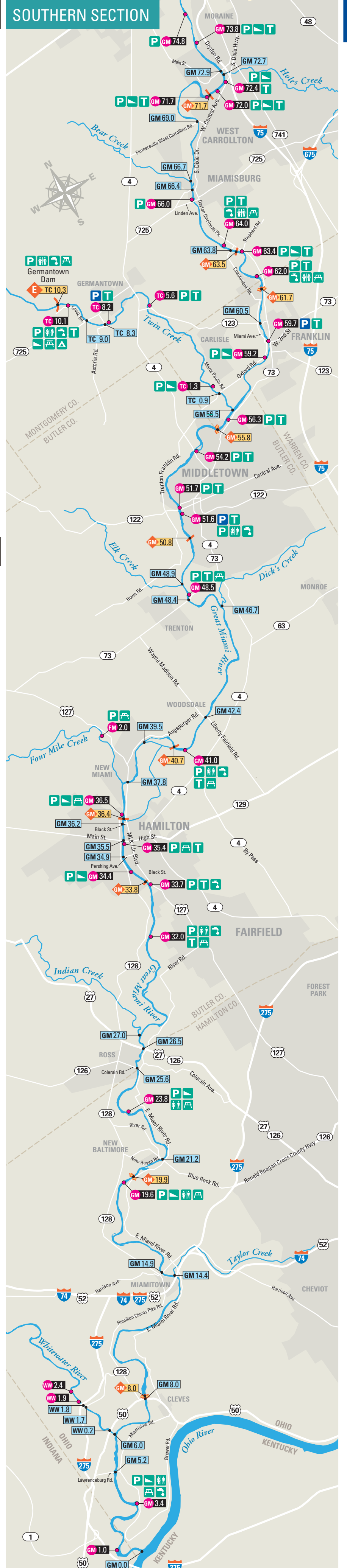
